STEM IMPLEMENTATION

STEM is an education curriculum that focuses heavily on the subjects of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics

STEM schools and programmes approach these key educational subjects in an integrated way so that elements of each subject are applied to the others. STEM-focused learning programmes span from preschool through to college master's degree programmes, depending on resources within a given school system.

- 2. A range of STEM initiatives will be phased into KIK and SIS over the coming academic year. These will include STEM Corners and STEM linked themes in kindergarten classrooms to guide learning activities. STEM clubs will be introduced at our schools as well as holding special STEM days during the school year. Teachers will also provide STEM classroom learning activities that are multidisciplinary and designed to promote critical thinking and build problem solving skills.
- KinderWorld is collaborating with our US partner, TinkRworks to provide training for Expat and Vietnamese teachers.
