Long, long ago, when I had my first calculator, it had five functions  $+ - x \div \sqrt{.1}$  had the pleasure of using a book of Log Tables (NOT!) and, later a Slide Rule (I actually enjoyed that...)Today's calculators have so many Modes and so many Functions, I doubt whether anybody knows how to use them all. But our Year 8 International students have learnt the use of the "sin" "cos" "tan" functions and know how to use them successfully to solve problems in triangles. And our Additional Maths students (IGCSE2) have discovered many new functions - "log" "In" "e<sup>x</sup>" "10<sup>x</sup> "x! "nP<sub>r</sub>" and "nC<sub>r</sub>"

I wonder how many parents out there have ever used these functions on a calculator?



Recently, we have been learning about **Trigonometric Ratios**. We have learnt how to use the **"sin" "cos" "tan"** functions on our calculators. These functions help us to find the angles and sides of a triangle. Geometry allow us to integrate the things that we have learnt from the lessons into our daily life. We really enjoy gaining more knowledge about this chapter.


